- 1. APAS federal election proposals: A federal election was recently called and APAS released its federal election proposals we're sending the document to all federal political parties and candidates. Our proposals include improving BRM programs, fixing rural connectivity, investing in trade infrastructure, and getting more carbon tax exemptions for producers, plus others. - 2. \$500 million in new AgriRecovery funding: On August 15 the federal government announced \$500 million in new AgriRecovery funding for producers that have been hard-hit by the drought. We're currently watching for more details on how that money will be distributed, but any extra support for producers is appreciated. - 3. APAS District Meetings completed: We just finished holding our six APAS District Meetings around the province thanks to everyone that attended, even though you were busy with harvest. We'll do another round of District Meetings later this year before the APAS Policy Conference.
- 4. CFA Agriculture Leaders Debate: The Canadian Federation of Agriculture (CFA) will be hosting an Agriculture Leaders Debate on September 9, which will be livestreamed on Facebook and YouTube. This event will bring together the federal Minister of Agriculture and Agriculture Critics from each federal party to debate how their parties would fix the top issues facing agricultural producers.
